Camping in West Sedona NEW RULE CHANGES COMING SOON

CAMPING WILL BE PERMITTED IN DESIGNATED AREAS ONLY.

- Eight locations will be designated for camping in the West Sedona area. (See map on back)
- · Campfires and charcoal will be prohibited.
- Stoves, grills, and fire pits operating solely on liquid propane will be permitted.

WHEN WILL THESE CHANGES GO INTO EFFECT?

 Spring of 2022. The Forest Service will give ample notice and have information kiosks and regulatory signage in high profile locations.

WHY IS THE FOREST SERVICE MAKING THESE CHANGES?

- · Reduce wildfire risk in area.
- Improve wildlife and cattle grazing and access to water.
- Protect the fragile desert environment.
 Cryptobiotic soil in the area is very unique and easily destroyed.
- Permit Law Enforcement personnel to better patrol, protect, and serve.
- The volume of overnight use in the West Sedona area has reached a saturation limit, and the current camping impacts are unsustainable.


